ANNOUNCEMENT FOR ADMISSION TO THE FIVE-YEAR B.A., LL.B. DEGREE PROGRAMME FOR CLAT - 2009 CANDIDATES

O.P. Jindal Global University (JGU) is pleased to announce that the Government of Haryana has approved the Common Law Admissions Test (CLAT) - 2009 as an additional eligibility criterion for admission to the five year B.A., LL.B. degree programme at the Jindal Global Law School (JGLS) in 2009.

Applicants who were not aware of the Law School Admissions Test – India (LSAT – India) and who therefore did not take that Test for admission to JGLS now have the opportunity to seek admission through their CLAT scores, by submitting an application on or before **Friday, 7 August 2009**.

The following procedure and criteria will apply:

1. Applicants must possess the minimum eligibility criteria of an aggregate of 50% or above in the Class XII or equivalent examination and should have taken CLAT in 2009.
2. Applications may be completed online via www.jgls.org. The application can also be submitted by post to the Registrar, O.P. Jindal Global University, 12, Jindal Centre, Bhikaiji Cama Place, New Delhi - 110066.
3. The JGLS Admissions Committee will consider applications purely on merit on the basis of the applicant's CLAT ranking coupled with the aggregate of 50% or above in the Class XII examination.
4. Scholarships, Fellowships or Fee Concessions are not available for CLAT applicants and applications approved for admission will be on a full fee basis.

About JGU and JGLS

O.P. Jindal Global University, a non-profit University, is established by the Haryana Private Universities (Second Amendment) Act, 2009 at Sonapat, Haryana (NCR of Delhi). Jindal Global Law School is the first school of JGU. JGU and JGLS are recognised by the Bar Council of India (BCI).
